SUMMARY OF DUTIES: Good Samaritan Health Center of Cobb is a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) that currently provides full service medical, dental, and medication dispensary services. In order to expand our services available to our patients, we are pleased to expand our services to include Behavioral Health. The Psychiatric Advanced Practice Practitioner will offer Behavioral Health services to patients with various medical and psychosocial problems utilizing behavioral modifications and evidence-based psychiatric interventions. Services provided by the Psychiatric APP will include consultation to primary care providers and behavioral health consultants, diagnosis and treatment of psychiatric conditions, and medical therapy for psychiatric conditions. This is a full time position.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Can fulfill the clinic's mission to spread the love of Christ through quality healthcare to those in need while providing appropriate physical, emotional, and spiritual care for the whole person.
- 2. Provide comprehensive assessment and diagnosis of behavioral health clients.
- **3.** Provide effective treatment planning and assisting clients in successfully achieving goals.
- **4.** Evaluate crisis situations and apply appropriate interventions.
- **5.** Assist in the detection of "at risk" patients and development of plans to prevent further psychological or physical deterioration.
- **6.** Provide assessment, consultation, and brief intervention for psychological/psychiatric problems and/or disorders.
- **7.** Provide psychoeducation to patients and families including care, prevention, and treatment enhancement techniques
- **8.** Function as a part of a fully integrated primary care/behavioral health care team
- **9.** Provide direct psychiatric services through the comprehensive evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment of patients, including prescribing and administering medications
- **10.** Participate on quality assurance, educational, and professional committees or training as assigned by the Medical/Quality Director

• Current licensure as a Board Certified Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant in the state of Georgia

EXPERIENCE:

• 2+ years of clinical psychiatric experience

SKILLS:

- Ability to deliver evidence-based psychological interventions to treat and manage conditions common to primary care including but not limited to: depression, anxiety, insomnia, chronic pain, substance abuse, and chronic medical conditions
- Effectively uses screening and outcome tools
- Excellent and timely clinical documentation within an electronic health record
- Strong crisis management skills
- General knowledge of psychotropic medications and chronic medical conditions common to primary care
- Flexible, effective consultant that is able to work effectively on a primary care team
- Ability to demonstrate compassion and caring interacting with others in a way that supports the Center's mission to share the love of Christ through high quality healthcare to those in need

ENVIRONMENTAL/ WORKING CONDITIONS:

• Combination of medical office and exam / procedure room setting which is a well-lit, well-ventilated, adequate space.

PHYSICAL/ MENTAL DEMANDS:

- Must be able to use appropriate body mechanics techniques when making necessary patient transfers and helping patients with walking, dressing, etc. Must be able to lift up to 40 pounds.
- Hearing / Speaking: Effective communications with patients, staff and visitors.
- Standing: 40% of the workday
 Sitting: 20% of the workday
 Walking: 30% of the workday
 Lifting: 10% of the workday
