The impact that Good Sam has had on my life goes far beyond what I could have imagined. It has been a journey of spiritual growth, healing, and learning to fully trust in God. I had recently lost my dad in 2021, and the weight of that grief was something I didn't know how to carry. I've learned to surrender more fully, to let go of the need to control everything, and to trust that God's plan is always bigger and better than anything I can see in the moment. Even when life doesn't make sense, I've come to believe that He is still good, still working, and still writing my story with purpose.

Good Sam wasn't just a place of healing for others—it became that for me, too. A place where I found hope again, where my spirit was restored, and where I began walking in faith with a confidence I never thought I'd have.

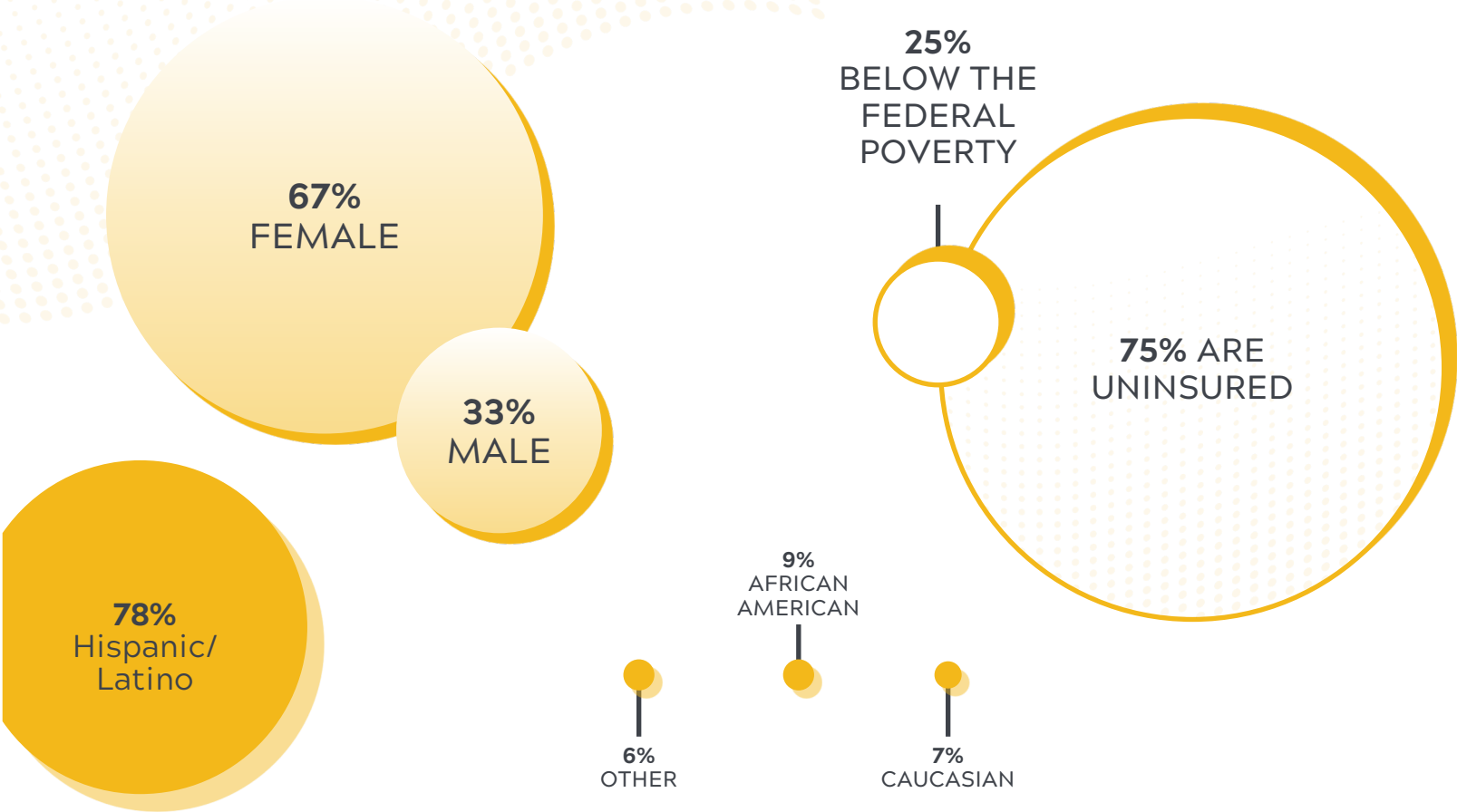

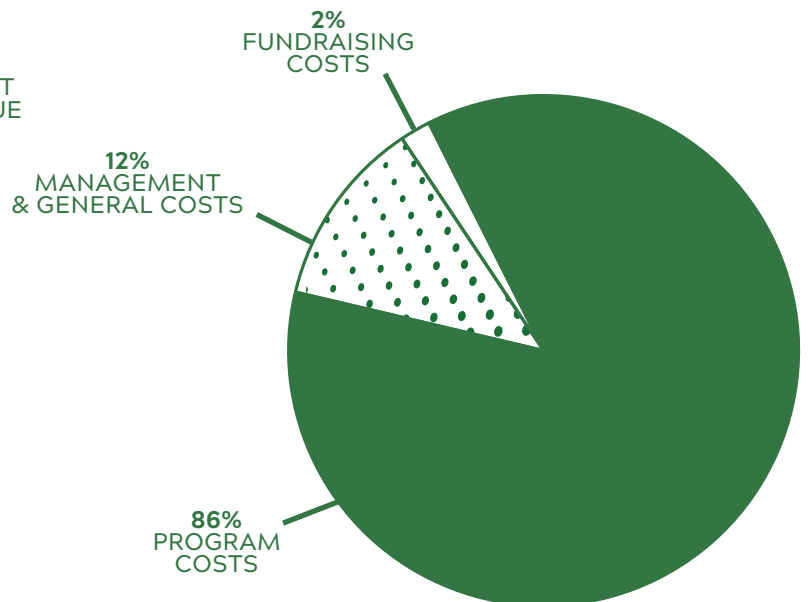
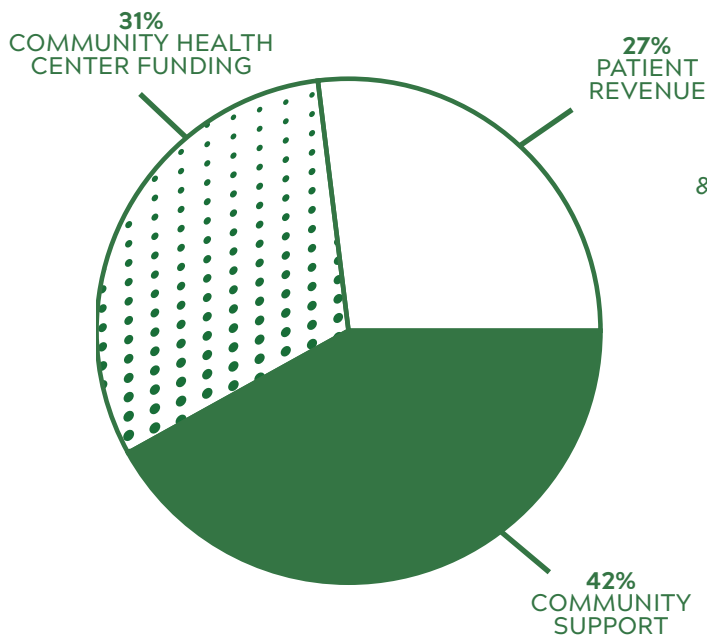
